






Eetcafé de Vergulde Vos




Café De Haven




Wagenaar Koffie & Diner




Bakker Van Maanen





Wijn & Thijs




De Rozeboom





Keizer Partycentrum, Biljartzaal en Café





Apolonia Pizzeria

Location: Weteringlaan 5, 2377 XN Oude Wetering




Recreation

After a long week, you may simply want to relax. Make a picnic with your friends, or simply enjoy the nature.




Roelofarendsveen

A picnic table couple meters away from Ringvaartaquaduct, with a playground and a park next to it.




Buitenkaag

A place with a beautiful view on a Dieperpoel lake, with a place to dock and place to sit down and relax.


Waterways

Some places are more difficult to reach than the others. Here is the map of places that you may want to reach, that require some extra attention.




Centrum of Roelofarendsveen

To reach the centrum, you must enter a canal next to [Café De Haven](#) and [Wagenaar Koffie & Diner](#) and carry on through the lake, passing the water gate. You must take the first right and continue until you pass the first bridge and then second – after which you must take right. From there, it's a straight and easy cruise.



Leimuiden

If you want to reach [Keijzer Partycentrum](#) and [De Rozeboom](#), it's very simple. In the middle of the Oude Wetering canal, you must enter the Drecht canal. From there it's straight sail to your destination!




Rijpwetering

Getting to Rijpwetering is the trickiest of the bunch. Depending on where you are, you must head South or South-West from Aderploder canal and follow the major canal in the direction of Rijpwetering. This will allow you to reach the [De Vergulde Vos](#) café.


Ferries

While traveling across the Kaag en Brassem, you may encounter ferries, which you must let through.




Raised Bridges

There are several raised bridges that you will encounter – while you may be able to slip under one, many of them during sunny day may have a large amount of traffic waiting for it to be raised, so be careful!




Manually Raised Bridges

There are a few manually raised bridges that are not operated by a machine, for these you must get out of your vessel and raise it yourself...



Water-gate

Only one is found in the Kaag en Brassem, located next to Wagenaar Koffie & Diner and Café de Haven. You must level out evenly the water level in a slip gate, to continue your journey.



Traffic Warnings

Some canals are busier than the others - mainly due to the fact that through Kaag en Brassem goes one of main water roads from Rotterdam to Amsterdam. That means you must be careful, here are canals that can get busy when it's a nice day.
